



THE PRINCE ALBERT II OF MONACO FOUNDATION'S ENVIRONMENTAL PHOTOGRAPHY AWARD: "HUMANITY & WILDLIFE" EXHIBITION.

Hall of States, The Kennedy Center October 26 – November 20, 2022 Free & Open to the Public

The John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington D.C., in conjunction with its presentation of Les Ballets de Monte-Carlo, will display 32 beautiful photographs that have competed for the Prince Albert II of Monaco Foundation's Environmental Photography Award since 2021, focusing on the theme "Humanity & Wildlife: Crossed Destinies, Shared Territories".

Examining our relationship with wildlife means rethinking people's place in the environment. It means forging close links with the nature around us by recognizing its beauty at the same time as looking clearly at the threats we pose to its future. It also means maintaining the hope that together we will succeed in creating a new sustainable balance. Through the photographers' eyes, three points of view diverge and connect – *Incredible Wildlife*, *Wildlife* in *Crisis* and *Reasons* for *Hope*. The contrast between the incredible beauty of wildlife and the terrible impact of human activities on habitats, which threatens the survival of thousands of species, compels us to take collective action to support our planet's life and health.

The exhibition, supported by the Prince Albert II of Monaco Foundation- USA and the Embassy of Monaco, will coincide with the launch of the third edition of the Environmental Photography Award of the Foundation in 2022, dedicated to the reflection on our relationship towards nature and interrelation between human health and planetary health. About the Environmental Photography Award

The Prince Albert II of Monaco Foundation Environmental Photography Award was launched in 2021, in honor of the Foundation's 15th anniversary. This annual award was created with the aim to reward photographers who put their creativity to good use in raising awareness on Earth protection. The Environmental Photography Award has the dual purpose of celebrating the incredible beauty of our planet and highlighting the environmental challenges we face, encompassing both impacts and solutions. The photographs are carefully selected by a jury of internationally renowned professional photographers for their technical and aesthetic excellence but also, and above all, for the relevance and strength of their message. Photographic art, with its immediate and universal language, represents a formidable vehicle for raising awareness.
